

JUSTIN BARRON (HE/HIM) HAS SPENT THE BETTER PART OF A DECADE PLAYING MAKE BELIEVE. HIS CAREER IN THE ARTS HAS TAKEN HIM TO MANY UNEXPECTED PLACES BUT IT ALL BEGAN BACK IN 2014 UPON GRADUATING FROM UCM WITH A BFA IN MUSICAL THEATRE. SOON AFTER, JUSTIN BEGAN A JOURNEY THAT WOULD LEAD HIM TO THE STAGES OF HEART OF AMERICA SHAKESPEARE FESTIVAL, UNICORN THEATRE, COTERIE THEATRE, KANSAS CITY REPERTORY THEATRE, CREEDE REPERTORY THEATRE, AND MANY MORE. HIS PASSION FOR PERFORMANCE, DIRECTING, AND WRITING BLED OVER INTO A NEW CAREER PATH WHEN HE SUDDENLY FOUND HIMSELF WITHOUT A JOB DURING THE COVID PANDEMIC, A PATH THAT WOULD LEAD HIM TO BEGIN TIPSY BARD KC.



JUSTIN DISCOVERED TABLETOP ROLEPLAYING GAMES (TTRPGS) BACK IN 2015 WHILE DOING SUMMER STOCK THEATRE BUT HAD NO IDEA IT COULD BECOME MORE THAN JUST A HOBBY. HOWEVER, DURING THE PANDEMIC, HE STARTED BUILDING A COMMUNITY OF THEATRE FRIENDS WHO FOUND JUST AS MUCH JOY AND CATHARSIS IN ROLEPLAYING AS HE DID. TOGETHER, HE AND HIS TEAM RAN A SLEW OF DIVERSE GAMES, LEARNING NEW SYSTEMS AND BUILDING THEIR NETWORK. IN 2023, JUSTIN DECIDED TO MAKE IT OFFICIAL AND STARTED TIPSY BARD KC, A SMALL BUSINESS START-UP FOCUSING ON SHARING THEIR LOVE OF TTRPGS WITH FOLKS ALL AROUND THE KC AREA. IN THEIR FIRST YEAR OF BUSINESS, THEY'VE GROWN A GREAT COMMUNITY OF GAMERS THROUGH PUBLIC EPIC TTRPG EVENTS AS WELL AS PRIVATE IN-HOME PARTIES. HIS PLAYS HAVE BEEN PERFORMED INTERNATIONALLY: ONSTAGE, ATLANTIC - A COLLABORATION WITH THE ROYAL CONSERVATOIRE OF SCOTLAND AND HIS ALMA MATER NORTHWESTERN UNIVERSITY - WON CRITICAL ACCLAIM AT EDINBURGH FRINGE AND DREAM TICKET (PLAYERS THEATRE, OFF-BROADWAY) WON THE NY FRINGE EXCELLENCE AWARD AND WAS RECOMMENDED BY THE HUFFINGTON POST AND TIMEOUT. IN ADDITION TO THEIR DESIGN WORK, THEY MOONLIGHT AS A POET AND DIGITAL ARTIST. SELBY IS AN AVID PROPONENT OF THE ARTS, AND FEELS LUCKY TO BE AFFORDED THE OPPORTUNITY TO ADD THEIR VOICE TO SUCH AN IMPORTANT MEDIUM.

FOUNDING ARTISTIC AND EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, HEATHER LOEWENSTEIN STARTED STONELION PUPPET THEATRE THIRTY-TWO YEARS AGO WHEN SHE DISCOVERED PUPPETRY MELDED PERFORMANCE AND DESIGN INTO ONE BIG LUMP OF FUN THAT COULD COMMUNICATE COMPLEX IDEAS AND MESSAGES IN A WAY THAT TRADITIONAL THEATER COULD NOT. SHE HAS PASSION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION AND THE NEED TO TEACH THE NEXT GENERATIONS ABOUT PROTECTING OUR WORLD'S WATER SYSTEM WHICH IS TRANSLATED INTO ALL OF HER COMPANY'S WORK.

SHE HAS PRODUCED, DIRECTED, DESIGNED PERFORMED AND/OR WRITTEN OVER ONE HUNDRED FULL SCALE PRODUCTIONS FOR SPT. DIRECTORIAL AND DESIGN CREDITS INCLUDE FOUR YEARS OF GIANT ILLUMINATED PUPPETS IN PUPPETS A GLOW-GO ANNUALLY REACHING 15,000 AREA CITIZENS. FOR FIFTEEN YEARS MOTHER'S DAY FOR MOTHER EARTH WOWED AUDIENCES AND GREW TO BE THE LARGEST FREE COMMUNITY FAMILY ART EVENT IN THE MIDWEST, WHERE THE PUBLIC ACTUALLY HELPS PARTICIPATES IN CREATING THE GIANT PUPPETS...ALL FOCUSED ON CLEAN WATER. SHE WAS THE PUPPET DESIGNER AND PERFORMER THAT HELPED LOCAL KANSAS CITY PUBLIC TELEVISION WIN A REGIONAL EMMY FOR "BARK PARK PLACE" IN 2001. HER PRODUCTION OF "BACKYARD BUGGIN" FOR POINT DEFIANCE ZOO AND AQUARIUM WON THE AMERICAN ZOOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION (AZA) AWARD FOR ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION IN 2006 AND IN 2011 HEATHER WAS GIVEN THE AWARD OF EXCELLENCE IN CONSERVATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION NON-PROFIT BY KANSAS ASSOCIATION OF CONSERVATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION. SHE WAS AWARDED THE LIGHTON PRIZE AS TEACHING ARTIST OF THE YEAR 2016.



SHE HAS WORKED AS A US STATE DEPARTMENT SPONSORED ARTIST FOR THE PAST EIGHT YEARS TRAINING TEACHERS AND THE COMMUNITY TO USE ART TO PROTECT OUR PLANET AND REDUCE PLASTIC IN FIJI, LAOS, VIETNAM, UKRAINE, ISRAEL, KENYA AND NEXT YEAR UGANDA.

HER PERFORMANCES HAVE BEEN A REGULAR PART OF PROGRAMMING AT THE NELSON-ATKINS MUSEUM OF ART (KANSAS CITY, MO) CRYSTAL BRIDGES ART MUSEUM(BENTONVILLE, AR) THE KEMPER MUSEUM OF CONTEMPORARY ART (KANSAS CITY, MO) AND THE SMITHSONIAN INSTITUTE (WASHINGTON D.C.) AND LAST YEAR AT THE MIDWEST TRUST CENTER. HER WORK WITH SPT HAS ALSO BEEN SPONSORED BY THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS IN THE UNITED STATES. LAST YEAR STONELION UNDER HER DIRECTION GAVE 247 PERFORMANCES AND WORKSHOPS.

CURRENTLY SHE IS WORKING ON A COLLABORATION WITH THE ST. LOUIS SYMPHONY TO CREATE AN ORIGINAL GIANT PUPPET PLAY CELEBRATING WATER TO DEBUT THE SPRING OF 2026.

IN ADDITION TO WORK BACKSTAGE, HE ALSO MAINTAINS AN ACTIVE PERFORMING SCHEDULE IN OPERAS AND RECITALS, WITH PERFORMANCES WITH THE LYRIC OPERA OF KANSAS CITY CHORUS, LAWRENCE OPERA THEATRE, AND CLASSICAL MUSIC EXPRESS AND OTHER LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS.
