
Understanding the UCM Scholarship Finder

Step 1: Logging into your Account

To access the UCM Scholarship Finder, you will go to <u>ucmo.academicworks.com</u> and select the "Sign In" tab in the upper right hand corner of the page.

Should you be unsure of your UCM Credentials to log in, please reach out to the Technology Support Center at 660-543-4357 and they can help you access your account.




The UCM Scholarship Finder application for the 2026-2027 school year should open to students by August 15, 2025.

The application's priority deadline is February 01, 2026 and all applications will close March 15, 2026.


Step 2: Updating your General Application

When students first log in, the system will take them to the below screen and while the check-mark next to the general application may make you think this step is done, it is not! Click on the "General Application" tab and answer the requested questions.



Step 3: Applying for Recommended Opportunities

Once you have answered all 12 questions and updated your application, the system will automatically apply you for all the scholarships you qualify for. The system will automatically take you to the "Other Recommended Opportunities" screen in which the system will recommend other scholarships for you to apply for. You must actually click into these opportunities to see what additional information they need from you to apply. Please note that you may not qualify for all of the recommended scholarships, but the system is trying to cast the widest net possible for you to apply for.



Step 4: Applying for Additional Opportunities

Once you have viewed all of the recommended opportunities mentioned above, you can go to the "All Opportunities" tab. This tab will show you the scholarships that the system automatically applied for, as well as any recommended opportunities you applied for.

Should the scholarship opportunity have a "None" under the actions column, the system has either determined that you do not qualify, or have already applied for it! Should it show an "Apply" under the actions column, you will need to click into the opportunity, read the eligibility criteria and determine if you can/should apply. Please note that many of these opportunities may require additional information or documentation from you.
