Terms of Meal (Board) Agreement

- A. Eligibility: The applicant must be a currently enrolled student. Students who are required to reside on campus (students under 21 years of age with less than 60 UCM accepted credit hours who have not lived on campus for 2 years) are required to be on one of the three designated meal plans for the entire academic year (Plans 1-3). Faculty and staff are able to purchase dining dollars.
- B. Terms of agreement: This agreement is for the *entire academic year*, both fall and spring semesters. The residential dining centers are closed during semester breaks and holidays. There will also be limited-service hours in the Union during semester breaks and holidays. Any semester add-ons will be added to and billed with your semester plan. Students who wish to change their meal plans can do so by **August 22**, **2025** for the fall semester or by **January 16**, **2026** for the spring semester. Meal plan changes can be made in the Office of University Housing, Ellis Complex or on MyCentral.
- C. Rates: The cost listed is a per semester price. Students will be automatically billed at the beginning of each semester. Purchases made after **August 22, 2025** for the fall semester and **January 16, 2026** for the spring semester must be paid for at the time of the purchase.
- D. Dining dollars and meals: Unused dining dollars can be carried from semester to semester as long as the student is continuously enrolled in the university. There is no refund of funds in the dining dollars account. Meals purchased for a particular semester can only be used during that particular semester. Remaining meals and guest passes do not carry forward and are nonrefundable.
- E. Access Plan restriction: The Access Plan is for the use of the plan holder only. Access to the dining hall is **not** transferable under any circumstances.
- F. You <u>must</u> present your UCM Mule Card (ID card or mobile ID) each time you enter the residence hall dining center or spend your dining dollars at retail locations. **No exceptions.**
- G. Withdrawal from the university: If the student leaves the university during the term of this agreement, the student agrees to pay for all meals served and dining dollars used to the time of checking out of the halls or the daily rate, whichever is greater, plus 10% of the student's remaining meal plan and add-on value for the semester in which the withdrawal occurs.
- H. Cancellation by student remaining at the university:
 - Students who are *not required* to have a meal plan may cancel this agreement in writing for the spring semester by **December 12, 2025** with no penalty. Cancellations by students who are enrolled will not be allowed after this date.
 - Students who *are required* to have a meal plan are not able to cancel their meal plan agreement unless they cancel their housing agreement according to the terms in the housing agreement.
 - Students who cancel their housing according to the terms of the housing agreement may also cancel their meal plan if they agree to pay for meals served up to the cancellation date, or the daily rate, whichever is greater, plus 10% of the student's food service rate for the remainder of the academic year.
- I. Termination for violation of university regulation: The student herby consents and agrees to the right of the university to terminate this agreement for breach of university policies and regulations concerning behavior while in residence halls after the student exercises his/her right to due process contained in the current edition of the *University of Central Missouri Guide to Good Decision-Making*. In the event of termination of this agreement by the university as a result of the student violating such policies/procedures, the student will be liable to pay for all meals served and dining dollars used to the time of checking out of the halls or the daily rate, whichever is greater, plus 10% of the student's remaining meal plan and any add-ons for the semester in which the withdrawal occurs.
- J. Inactive agreements: Students with carry forward dining dollars who are inactive in excess of twelve months will be deactivated and cancelled.
