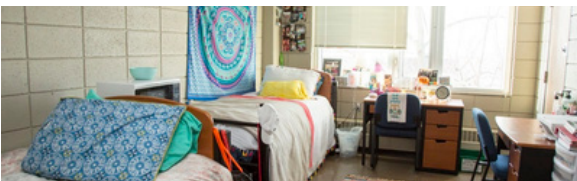

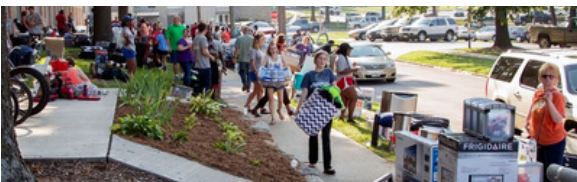


### WE ARE 8 WEEKS AWAY FROM MOVE-IN!

# HOUSING SERVICES

## Designed to Make Your Life Easier & Better

Prepping for life on campus or move-in can be a lot of work! University Housing and United Student Housing Association (USHA) provide a variety of optional services to make your life on campus more convenient including:



**Loft Rental** - Order your loft via College Products and pick up the unit on opening day. Cost for the year is \$145 before August 1 and \$165 after. If you want to loft your bed, this is the company you are required to rent from. Order at [collegeproducts.com/store/ucm](http://collegeproducts.com/store/ucm)



**Safe Purchase** - Purchase your safe from College products. Safes will be directly shipped to you so you can bring it on opening day. Cost of a safe is \$145. Order at [collegeproducts.com/store/ucm](http://collegeproducts.com/store/ucm)



**Linen & Room Essential Purchase** - Purchase bedding/other residence hall room essentials from On Campus Marketing. Proceeds benefit student programming and leadership engagement. Cost depends on the package you purchase. All packages are mailed to your home so you can bring them with you on opening day. Order at [ucmo.edu/housingservices](http://ucmo.edu/housingservices)



**Refrigerator and Microwave Rental** - Rent a refrigerator and/or microwave and pick it up on opening day. Fridge fee is \$70 for the year with a \$20 refund given upon return. Microwave fee is \$35 for the year with a \$15 refund given upon return. Feel free to bring your own but be sure they uses 1000 or less watts. 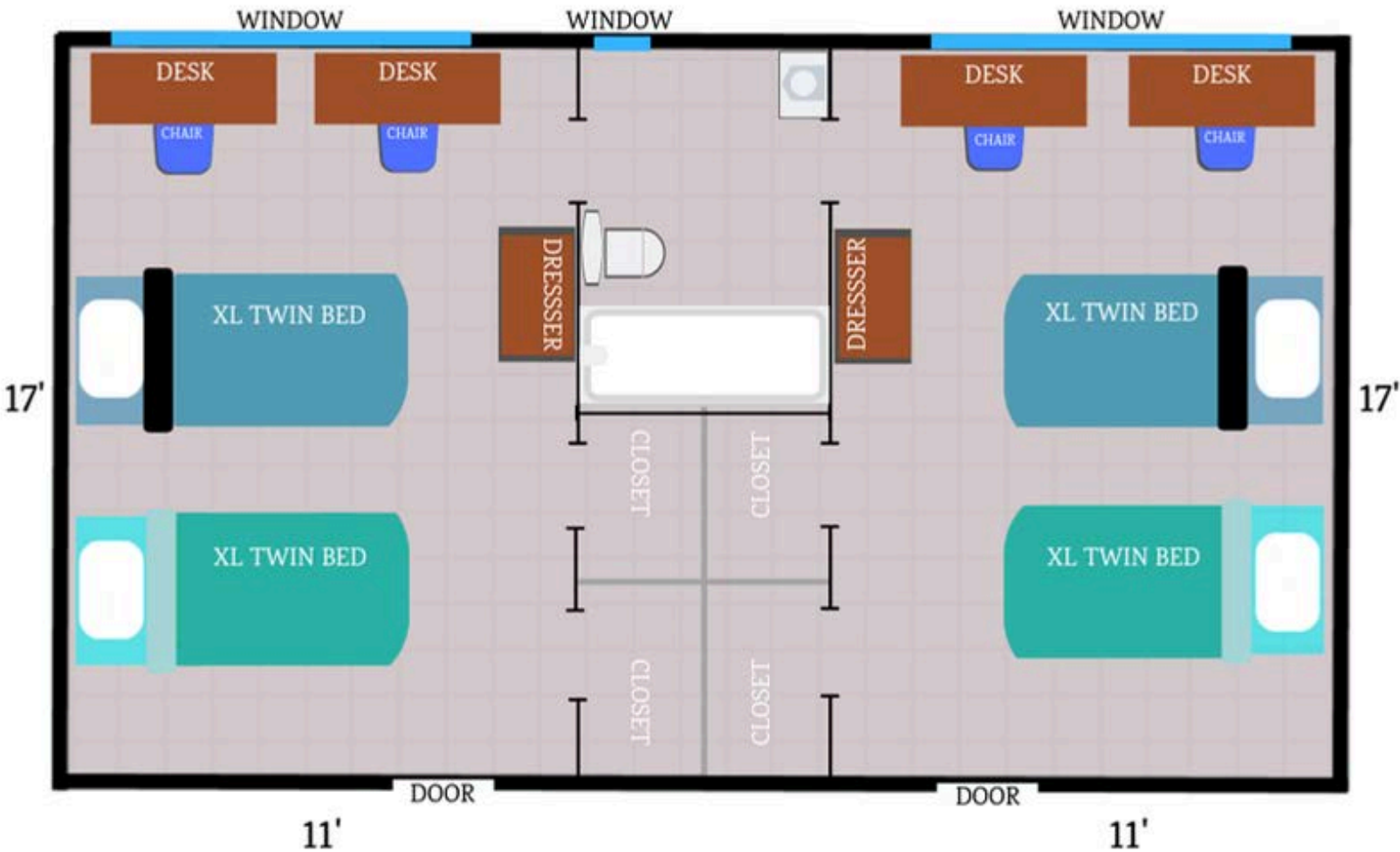

# ROOMMATES & SUITEMATES

## Establishing Great Relationships

Part of the on campus experience is having a roommate and/or suitemate. Creating relationships is vital as you start your UCM Journey. Find your roommate/ suitemate's information by logging onto the Housing Assignment Gateway in MyCentral under Student Records and Registration.



Your relationship with your roommate/suitemates is very important to your success at UCM. Students at UCM agree that getting in touch before you arrive takes pressure off the first day. You are encouraged to contact your suitemate to begin laying the groundwork.

Find out what TV shows, types of music, or activities your suitemate likes. Discuss class schedules, morning routines, and cleaning of the bathrooms! Remember, we are all unique and different in our backgrounds, values, and attitudes.

All students will get a resource sheet on recommended bathroom cleaning.

Roommate agreements are required and we also have suitemate agreements as a resource.

## MOVE-IN DAY: REQUIRED SIGN UP

As you plan for move-in, please know we will not be restricting guest numbers this year, however, we do require that only the student enter at first to obtain their key. Once their key is picked up, all guests may enter and assist. We appreciate the cooperation as we keep our lobbies/curbsides less congested. Students will be emailed their link to sign up for a check-in time. This will be sent out in mid/late July.

## WIFI, ETHERNET & STREAMING

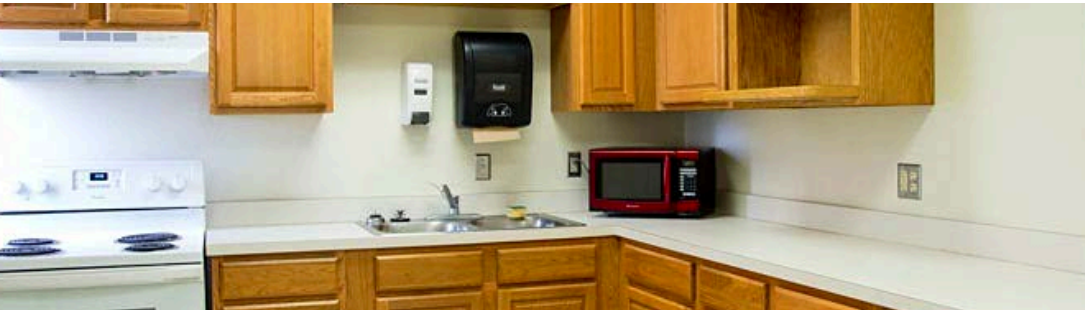
UCM no longer provides cable within the residence halls or apartments. However, the Office of Technology has created a process for students to register various devices if students wish to stream their favorite shows, movies, or play their favorite video games.

Rooms and commons areas have wifi and within rooms you will find an ethernet port. If you and your roommate both plan to use ethernet for any reason, a splitter would be required.

Please note that personal routers are not allowed on campus as they interfere with the university's network. Helpful information regarding getting the most out of your WiFi signal can be found on the Technology Support Center page.

***Register devices at [student.devices.ucmo.edu](http://student.devices.ucmo.edu)***

Students are allowed to register 3 devices. Devices that can connect wireless include various game systems, smart TVs, streaming devices (such as Roku, Firestick, etc).



## ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

***A Community That is Safety Conscious***

When students live in close proximity, poor decisions or careless choices can significantly impact on the safety of others. For this reason, we are very restrictive with personal items that could pose a risk to others or that pose even a small risk of fire. This includes prohibited items including:

- Scented wax cube warmers
- Candles/Incense (no burnt wicks allowed)
- Hoverboards/Electric scooters
- Halogen lamps/lava lamps
- Weapons (as defined in Guide to Good Decision Making)
- Outdoor grills
- Hot plates
- Toaster ovens
- Space Heaters

Appliances allowed for use in student rooms:

Coffee Makers  
Microwaves

Other appliances must be used in community kitchen and must NEVER be left unattended
