



# Locating Housing Assignment in MyCentral

Login to your MyCentral Account





### Meningitis Immunization Status (Required Per State Law)

Meningitis - Per state of Missouri law, students cannot reside on campus without their meningitis information being up to date with the University.

At this point, your meningitis information is flagged as YES.

YES means your information is on file. NO means your information is not on file. Please submit your records to the University Health Center. Find out more at [ucmo.edu/immunizations](http://ucmo.edu/immunizations).

If your status is NO as it gets closer to opening, please bring a copy of your meningitis vaccination record with you when you check in. Note that you need to have been age 16 or older when receiving the vaccination in order for it to be valid. We cannot check you in if you do not have this on file!
